

National Training 2014 annual report

This has been a robust year for the National Training committee. We have been able to capitalize (literally!!) on the great work of the committee members over the last few years (and all those gone before).

The CGPA training committee is working on and aiming to develop:

1. Building faculty opportunities – the aim is that there will be at least 2 training opportunities tendered out to faculty every year. CGPA had our first contracted training for profit this year – Lethbridge - Using National curriculum. With payment – to CGPA national!!! And to our faculty !!! It was very successful and a win-win for all involved.
 2. The faculty registry is scheduled to be on line by December 2014.
 3. The plan is to develop a National Training program brochure which will be complete with 3 development streams and tiers within each.
 4. The goal is to hire a NTC development coordinator
 5. A new priority will be Continuous Professional Development. There is a student elective working with Jackie who will hopefully be able to take old DVD's and conference materials and develop on line programming opportunities – The target is that Revenue will begin at \$1,000, annually. Distributive learning development will be an ongoing focus and e- learning modules are the way of the future
 6. CGPA will design and offers experiential day at the CPA and CCPA (annually).
 7. The CGPA will have representation at IAGP and on International Standards committee
 8. CGPA will partner with Universities – and residency training programs to develop national programming and standards.
 9. The CGPA will seek input on programming and mental health service delivery. Health Institutions – with Clinical administrators and other professionals.
 10. The CGPA will consider lobbying local and national Government – with the goal of encouraging Senior administrators and bureaucrats to seek the views of the CGPA on issues related to mental health.
 11. The CGPA will seek collaborative opportunities with other non profit and externally-funded projects eg. MHCC
